The Winter Fest is a non-competitive event offering students an opportunity to perform a memorized piece of their choice. Vocal, piano, instrumental, and ensembles are welcome. There will be only one piano available on stage. All PPMTA General and Festival Standing Rules apply to this event.

This event can be used as a practice performance for those entering the Competitive Historical Era Festival. (Only one movement allowed.)

Entry fee: \$20 (non-refundable)

Registration deadline: Wednesday, **January 11, 2023 by 7 PM**. Registration is on the [Tenuto](#) site. Teachers choosing to pay by check must deliver checks to Sylvia Holt (3216 Austin Dr., Colorado Springs, CO 80909) by this time. No late registrations accepted.

Time limit: 6 minutes. Early elementary students with a piece less than 60 seconds long are allowed to play 2 pieces.

Students will receive written comments from a judge as well as a medal for participating.

The Winter Fest chairs would like to invite **adult students only** (college and older) to perform on the first recital of the day. All levels are welcome. Memorization is strongly encouraged but not mandatory for adults. Time limit will remain 6 minutes.

Students and families should block off that Saturday for the festival. No changes in scheduling will be made.
