**11/09/2021 ADDITION:** The Winterfest chairs would like to invite adult students only (college and older) to perform on the last recital of the day. All levels are welcome. Time limit will remain 6 minutes.

The Winter Fest is a non-competitive event offering students an opportunity to perform a memorized piece of repertoire of their choice. Vocal, instrumental, and ensembles along with piano are welcome. There will be only one piano available on stage.

This event can be used as a practice performance for those entering the Competitive Sonatina Festival in March. (Only one movement allowed.)

Entry fee: \$15 (non-refundable)

Registration deadline: Wednesday, **January 12, 2022 by 7 PM**. Registration will be on the Tenuto site. Teachers choosing to pay by check must deliver checks to Sylvia Holt (3216 Austin Dr., Colorado Springs, CO 80909) by this time. No late registrations accepted.

Time limit: 6 minutes. Early elementary students with a piece less than 60 seconds long are allowed to play 2 pieces.

Students will receive written comments from a judge as well as a medal for participating.

Students and families should block off that Saturday for the festival. No changes in scheduling will be made.
