

Jennifer Linn Bio

Jennifer Linn is a multi-talented pianist, composer, arranger and clinician. As a clinician, she has presented workshops, master classes, and showcases throughout the United States, Canada, and India. From 2009-2019 she held the title of Manager-Educational Piano for Hal Leonard LLC, the world's largest print music publisher. Ms. Linn is the editor and recording artist for the award winning *Journey Through the Classics* series and the G. Schirmer Performance Editions of Clementi: Sonatinas, Op. 36; Kuhlau: Selected Sonatinas; and Schumann: Selections from Album for the Young, Op. 68. Her original compositions for piano students have frequently been selected for the National Federation of Music Clubs festival, and other required repertoire lists worldwide. In 2020 Hal Leonard launched the *Jennifer Linn Series* featuring leveled piano collections of original compositions as well as arrangements.

Ms. Linn's teaching career spans more than 30 years and includes independent studio teaching of all ages, as well as group instruction and piano pedagogy at the university level. Ms. Linn received her B.M. with distinction and M.M. in piano performance from the University of Missouri-Kansas City (UMKC) Conservatory of Music where she was the winner of the Concerto-Aria competition. She was named the Outstanding Student in the Graduate piano division and given the prestigious Vice Chancellor's award for academic excellence and service. In 2013, The University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music and Dance named Ms. Linn the 2013 UMKC Alumni of the year. In 2020, she was presented with the Albert Nelson Marquis Lifetime Achievement Award as a leader in the fields of music and education.
